It was an honour & a privileged to judge BIS at the London & Home Counties Terrier Clubs Golden Jubilee Show. The Committee had certainly pulled out all the stops to commemorate the event with many 'Specials', a photographic Competition & a large Celebration Cake which was shared by all during the afternoon. Thanks for the invite, it was a lovely show with an excellent atmosphere & grand dogs to go over.

I found my **BIS** in Fallon's, Ch. Janeys Jimjams Jenson, JW, ShCM, a top quality SCW Terrier dog in the best of coats & condition, grand head with well set ears & of lovely type & balance, presenting a lovely profile as he flowed round the ring, excellent drive from good quarters, he looked a picture.

Reserve BIS was delightful Cairn bitch, Keeves, Ch. Seveek Living The Dream, JW, ShCM. Typey & on her toes, lovely expression with good stop & well set ears, best of fronts & shoulders, well ribbed up with good tail set, correct double coat, a good moving bitch that went well carrying a level top line with correct set on.

Group 3 was the Scottish Terrier, Torcraig Syduificant.

Group 4 the Wire Fox Terrier, Dominus Draughtman.

These two were both puppies & won through to Best Puppy & Reserve BPIS respectively.

Best Puppy In Show, Pagram's, Torcraig Syduificant, most delightful Scottie bitch puppy who stole my heart, wonderful expression with neatest of ears, dark eye & big teeth, nice length & balance to neck & body with strong loin & quarters, loved her to bits & she went like a dream beating a lovely Wire Fox Terrier, Hunt's, Dominus Draughtman, who was **Reserve BPIS**, so much to like about this young male, grand head, neck & body, presented in lovely coat & condition.

Puppy Group 3 was a red Bull Terrier, Miinroc Envy Me, & believe me, many will, for she is a lovely youngster, grand head & turn, well set ears, correct mouth, good from all angles with good front & feet, ample bone & well ribbed up for age, strong quarters, she looked a picture & went well.

Puppy Group 4, the Manchester Terrier, Mibre Bombette, nice size with pleasing feminine expression, dark eye, good front & shoulders, pleasing body & depth with nice cut up, good in profile with well set tail, lovely coat & condition.

3rd. Welch's, Ch. Brockland Brayhead Lad. Glen of Imaal.

1st – Mills - Miiroc Envy Me – 10 month old, feminine red & white bitch with a pleasing well balanced outline, head smooth in profile and well filled, well placed dark eyes, ears of good shape and size placed correctly and used well, lovely reach of neck into well laid shoulders, strong fore chest, straight front and tidy feet, correct top line & tail set, well sprung ribs, short coupled, good bend of stifles & low set hocks. Stood still this youngster looked like she would move well, and she did not disappoint, covering the ground with good reach at the front and strong drive from the rear it was a pleasure to award her the class, **BP & BOB**.

2nd – Painters – Urbanbully Lockdown.

Class 17 Bull terrier Post grad (3/0)

1st – Howes & Sheppard's - Polanca Powerslave – Large upstanding strongly built brindle and white dog, Strong head, unbroken profile, well filled, dark well placed eyes, and ears right on top, correct bite, long neck into well laid shoulders, straight front, good feet, strong round bone, well sprung ribs, well bent stifles and low set hocks, moved well both ways.

2nd – Kirk's – Kerbullys Rising Son.

1st – Taylor's – Ragnarok Fjalar – powerfully built, Red & White dog, a well-proportioned youngster just out of puppy, Strong head, smooth profile & packed with fill, correct bite, well placed dark eyes, ears of good size and shape carried and used well, good reach of neck into well laid shoulders, strong round bone, good feet, correct top line & tail set, great spring of rib and short coupled, correct rear angulation, once settled moved well both ways with great rear drive, pushed hard for BOB today but he's going to be a power house and just needs a bit more time to tighten it all up, one to watch. **RBOB**.

Open.(5) 1st. Nicholls, Zetamax Gossip Column. Tan marked dog with long clean head and neat ears. On the day eye appeared a little bold which took from expression. Has medium length of neck, short back, ribs well sprung, deep chest, well set tail sound on the move. **RBOB**. 2nd. Rogers, Falkmeres First Impression. 3rd. Robertsons, Equifax Silver Stargazer.

Puppy(4). Lovely to see four puppies headed by the male Hunts, Dominus Draughtsman with 2nd going to Bambridges , Neterntonian Sweet Chariot of Beckstone. A quality 11 months old bitch, well presented and handled. I thought the winning dog a real eye catcher with a long clean head of perfect balance, pleasing eye, neat well carried ears. Has fair length of neck and well laid shoulder, deep chest well sprung rib, short back with tail on top. Well muscled quarters, hocks well let down, moved with drive. **BP. BOB**. Well done on going **RBPIS**. 3rd. Russell-Smiths. Dominus Disaronno at Ritelsa.

P.G.1st.Caulfields, Netherntonian Songbird. Nice head proportions, dark eye, fair length of neck, reasonable depth of chest, short back , sound in movement.

Open Dog (3) 1st. Russell-Smiths Dawwen Flash Gordon At Ritelsa. Well made dog with long head, well placed dark eye. Good reach of neck, clean shoulders, level back, good set on.

Open Bitch(2) 1st.Smiths, Lenica Bright Ideas Sh Cm.Useful bitch with long narrow head, well placed ears, neck of fair length to well angulated shoulders, deep chest with good spring of rib. Strong body well set on tail, moves with drive on well muscled quarters. **B.B. & RBOB**.

P.G.(1) 1st.Mills, Zippers Snowman of Blackthorpe.A very nice type of dog who was not too happy to be handled today, however went over body okay to establish good depth of chest, spring of rib & well muscled quarters, moved well. **RBOB**.

Open (1). 1st. Sands, Seasmoult French Connection at Krakenexis. Pleasing bitch with balanced head, correct width, flat cheeks,strong square jaw, well set dark eye. Fair length of neck,well let down chest, medium length of body with good spring of rib, level topline with well set tail. Free movement. **BOB**.

Ears were a little erratic but when used, framed her head to perfection. In super coat and condition and well marked. Pleasing in outline when stood and movement so smooth and easy on the eye for one so young. Needs to tighten in shoulder but this will come. Very promising. Certainly one to watch. **BPIB &BPIS4**
2, Peachams Felfree A Touch Of Glam. Another girl of 10 months but different in type. A little heavier in bone and facial features but not masculine in any way. A beautiful dark almond eye compliments her wedged head. Unfortunately her ears though well set, were flying on the day. Good for body proportions but needing a touch more length of leg. Moved and handled very well.

PG 4 (0) 1, Turners Harkeats Lord Likely. Lots to like about this strong male. In excellent hard condition and shows a correct balanced, flowing outline when stood. However would like a little more length to neck. Strong head with a pleasing ear and eye. Excelled in body proportions with a deep chest, sweeping tuck and slight rise over his loin. Moved well in all directions. Easy class winner.
2, Fitches Westwyth Iron Lady. 2 Y O pretty girl of correct size. Finer all through but in proportion. Such a feminine head with a dark melting eye. Neck of good length set in well laid shoulders. Clean limbs and neat feet. Length and shape of body perfect for frame. Would like to see more reach and drive on the move.

OD 3 (2) 1, Pais' & Leighs Mansiya How Soon Is Now. 16 months with some maturing still to do. All male with a strong wedged head, & dark almond eye. Correctly set ears, but a little on the large side and not carried to his best advantage. Elegant all through, good muscle tone and gleaming coat with tan of rich colour. Good for bone and shapely in body leading to a strong well angulated rear. Movement steady, smooth in profile and straight coming and going. Handled to perfection. Just lacking that little spark which cost him in the challenge. **RBOB**

OB 6 (1) 1 Thurlows Erkenwyne Lady Guinevere. Well constructed & conditioned bitch. Compact and shapely. Very feminine with plenty of substance but not overdone in anyway. The glossiest of coats and firm in texture and rich clear tan markings. Such an attractive wedged head giving a good expression. Ears could be better carried but are of a good size. Well arched neck leading to a correct topline with a slight rise over her loin and well set on tail. Would like a little more turn of stifle to complete the picture. Positive, active movement from all directions. This girl never stopped showing. Pleased to award her **BOB**.
2, Wickers Mimbre Solitaire. The best head and ears of today's entry. Feminine yet strong and wedged. Starting to show her age in colour at nearly seven years but still well marked. In excellent coat and well muscled all through. Not the elegance of 1, with more bone and carrying a little too much weight on the day, which spoils her outline. Moved soundly with plenty of reach and drive.

Post Graduate (5 entries 2 abs) 1st Meyer's Coclestane Cinnamon, 3 year old tan and white bitch of good size. Lovely head all through leading in to good neck and shoulder, comfortably spanned, good top line. Moved ok, would like to see in harder condition. **RBOB** 2nd Pacolito Mistress at Llyunamill. **Open**

(3) 1st Blair & Hadley's Cleeve Hill Kasper, 3 year old all white dog. Good head with lovely dark eye, correctly made front with strong rear. In good coat and excellent condition. Very well schooled and handled show dog. Particularly coming and going this dog's movement is hard to fault, very sound and true. **BOB**. 2nd Boggia's Boughton Brassica. This nearly veteran tan/white dog could have learnt a few lessons from 1, however under the coat and reluctance to being in the ring there is much to like. Good, head, front and feet and excellent condition for age.

1. Charleton's Janeyjimjams Jemima. 4 year old bitch with a coat of good colour. Feminine head with dark eyes, small ears and a good mouth. Good reach of neck into good lay of shoulder. Nice straight front and good depth of chest. Topline level, which she held on the move. Would prefer slightly more bend of stifle but she was more than able to move well with lovely reach and drive. RBOB

Open: (3:1 abs)

1. Fallon's CH Janeyjimjams Jenson JW SHCM. The overall impression of this 4 year old boy is a well balanced, square and masculine dog, with a delightful wavy coat of excellent colour and texture. Strong head with good dark eyes, good ear set and nice mouth. Excellent reach of neck into good lay of shoulder. Level topline and good tailset. Lovely rear angulation. He moved easily, showing reach and drive, and holding his outline well. Very pleased to award him BOB and delighted to see him go on to win a well-deserved BIS.

2. Charleton's Snowmeadow Janey Jim Jams for Showadiwady. This 11 year old veteran lady can show some of the youngsters how to move. She has a pleasing easy movement with lovely reach and drive. A larger cast bitch, but still nicely balanced. Coat of good colour. Pleasing head. Good front and depth of chest. Level topline and tailset ok. Good rear angulation. She pushed her daughter for RBOB, just losing out this time. Very pleased to see her later take 2nd in AV Veteran Class.

3. Evans-Barry, Hammond & Evans' Villa Rosas Qorey. A heavier set masculine 8 year old dog, with a wonderful flowing Irish coat. Strong head. Good depth of chest. Topline ok and good rear angulation. Not moving well today though, which sadly let him down against the others.

1st – Hopkins & Gabel – Golden Boy Trufflestaff at Spirit Staffs (DEU.IMP)

11 month black brindle shown in lovely condition. Clean short coat. Balanced head with plenty of depth and strength. Ears could be neater but still have time to settle. Round dark eye. Strong neck flowing nicely. Neat front, plenty of bone, good strong forechest, enough depth to brisket and spring of rib at this stage. Topline good and holds on the move. Well developed hindquarters displaying correct angulation. Moved and handled well.

2nd – Mitchell and Ashtons - Our Little Cracker

10 month old blue dog. Lovely coat colour and condition with correct pigment. Lovely round dark eye and neat well placed ears. Smart front, correct shoulder placement and nicely developed well toned hindquarters. Would just like to see him develop in body to create a more overall balanced picture.

Junior Dog (3) (2)

1st Booth & Grimwoods – Ramblestaff Just Like Eddy

14 month old black brindle. Overall very balanced smart boy. Head of correct proportions, very clean all round. Eyes dark and round, ears neat and correctly placed. Super front with plenty of forechest. Brisket nice and deep and ribcage well sprung. Short couplings. Muscular well angulated hindquarters which enabled him to move with plenty of drive. A very nice young dog who I am sure will have a good show career ahead of him!

2nd – Butlers – Ramblestaff Cos I Could

13 month black brindle and white whom I also really liked and found out after both 1st and 2nd placed dogs are bred by the same breeder! To be honest these two could change places anytime! Just felt that the 1st placed dog had the edge on the day. Super neat head balanced throughout, beautiful dark eye enhancing expression, lovely ear carriage. Clean front shoulders well placed. Lovely topline and good hindquarters. Just needs to move a little faster to get the best out of him.

PGD (2)

1st Butlers – Ramblestaff Cos I Could

2nd Efreme – Ashbull O'Toole

Brindle dog of good all over balance. Strong clean head with well set neat ears. Eye dark and round. Excellent spring of rib and depth to brisket. Neck strong flowing onto well placed shoulders. Lovely topline both standing and on the move. Well handled.

Open Dog (3)

1st Dewars – CH Euphemia Drummer Boy JW

Black brindle dog of almost 7 years! An absolutely worthy Champion. This dog is super from all angles – completely balanced throughout and in superb condition which on the day earned him BOB over an outstanding Champion Bitch. Strong clean head displaying enough width and depth. Beautiful round dark eye, lovely expression and ears well placed. Super front, excellent forechest and depth to brisket. Ribcage well sprung, neck strong flowing into correct lay of shoulder. Neat well padded feet. Short coupled with excellent topline which he held on the move. Hindquarters well angulated and powerful. This dog is an excellent mover powers along freely with purpose.

Very well handled and pleased to see him selected for final consideration for BIS.

2nd Booth & Grimwoods – Ramblestaff Dirty Cash

Black brindle dog with lovely shaped head, good muzzle to skull ratios. Great expression enhanced by neat well placed ears. Good front displaying plenty of depth and ribcage well sprung. Correct shoulder, topline good. Excellent bend of stifle, well muscled hindquarters.

Moved and handled well.

3rd Paytons – Tonpay Barmy Army JW

Puppy Bitch (5)

1st Hopwood and Holts – Boldstock Here I Am

Brindle and white 10 months old. Very close decision between 1 and 2 (litter sisters). Smart clean head displaying enough width and depth at this stage. Lovely round dark eye and neat well placed ears all enhancing her expression. Nice neat front with plenty of depth at this stage. Well sprung rib for age. Topline good when standing and on the move, although a little longer than her sister I just preferred her overall look. Good bend of stifle, sound hindquarters moved well and handled to perfection. Pleased to award her Best Puppy in Breed.

2nd Canavans – Boldstock Am I Bovvered

Beautiful brindle, litter sister to 1st. A lot of the same attributes apply. Lovely round dark eye and super neat ears. Clean well shaped head, neat front again with plenty of width and depth. Powerful hindquarters and excellent topline both standing and on the move. Shown and handled well. I'm sure these 2 will change places many times. Two very nice puppies.

Junior Bitch (5) (3)

1st Booth & Grimwoods – Ramblestaff Out To Get You.

Black brindle 13 months so still very much a baby but really liked her. Beautiful clean head showing no looseness. Plenty of strength in muzzle and width to skull but not overdone.
